REGIONAL HEALTH & DISEASE SESSIONS

Wagga Wagga, 7-8 April 2009

These sessions will incorporate **real human pathology specimens** and related exhibits to provide students with a unique insight into the workings of the human body and the way in which their lifestyle can contribute to health and disease outcomes. Students will see and learn about diseases such as **cardiovascular disease, lung cancer, emphysema, melanoma, malaria, hydatids, diabetes, stroke** and many many more!

Each session will include a **35 minute introductory presentation** and time to explore the array of specimens and exhibits on display. Sessions will be **led by museum educators** and **syllabus-linked worksheets will be provided for students** with a particular focus on **Senior Biology** (9.4.2, 9.4.3, 9.4.4, 9.4.5, 9.4.6) and **Senior PDHPE** (9.1 (H1, H2)) outcomes.
